Software Licensing

NativeAccent® Annual Internet Revolving Single-User License

Authorizes each registered user login access to NativeAccent software from any internet connected computer. These revolving licenses may be re-registered to other users during the subscription year after the student completes the course or is otherwise un-enrolled from the program.

Annual subscription renewal fees are 20% of the first year subscription costs. Ideal for situations where there is limited access to school computing resources.

NativeAccent® Annual Internet Concurrent-User License

Defines the number internet workstations permitted concurrent access NativeAccent software from the institution, district, school or classroom. An unlimited number of users may be enrolled to use the software, but access is limited to the number of Internet “seats” purchased. This license allows flexible anytime/anywhere delivery of instruction into language labs on campuses and satellite locations across school districts, adult and community education sites, and institutions of higher learning and into student’s homes.
